## 2. Executive Committee – 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 – Clause C1

As a consequence of the Motion being carried, the Constitution: Part 4 – Rules of Procedure – Section 1 – Council Procedure Rules (Standing Orders) – Part V – Duration of Speeches – Standing Order 46 was amended to read:

"A member shall direct his speech to the matter under discussion or to a personal explanation or to a point of order. No speech shall exceed ten minutes except by prior consent of the Council. Any extension of time shall not exceed five minutes without the further consent of the Council, indicated by a vote if necessary.

This Standing Order shall not apply to the presentation of the annual budget by the Leader of the Council, nor to the Chairs of the Pensions Committee or Housing Committee in presenting their respective budgets to the Council, nor to the Leader or any Committee Chair in replying to debate."

#### 3. Pensions Committee – 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 – Clause C1
